

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Vote of Appreciation to the Honorable Barry Goldwater  
for support of Indian Select Committee

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised of the decision by the U.S. Senate  
2 to make the Senate Select Committee on Indian Affairs a permanent  
3 committee of the U.S. Senate; and


4 WHEREAS, Senator Barry Goldwater of Arizona was an ardent and influential  
5 supporter of the proposal to make the Senate Select Committee on  
6 Indian Affairs a permanent committee; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council realizes the tremendous value and meaning of  
8 the action taken by the Senate and the support and assistance of  
9 persons of Senator Goldwater's caliber and position;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby offers  
11 this vote of appreciation to the Honorable Barry Goldwater for  
12 the support and commitment he made towards accomplishment of this  
13 goal and further commends and recognizes Senator Goldwater for his  
14 long standing record and support of Indian Affairs.


15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
16 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
17 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant  
18 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Article V of the Constitution  
19 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago  
20 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on  
21 January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
22 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the  
23 Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
