


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Acceptance of Lamando Francisco Resignation as Tribal Council
Representative of the Pisinemo District



1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has authority to regulate its own procedures
2 pursuant to Article V, Section 2 (f) of the Constitution of the
3 Papago Tribe; and
4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council may pass such ordinances it deems necessary to the
5 exercise of its powers; and
6 WHEREAS, The Uniform Election Ordinance was enacted into law in 1978 by the
7 Papago Council and governs the conduct of elections; and
8 WHEREAS, Article III, Section 4 (b) of the Uniform Election ordinance provides
9 for the procedures governing term of office for Council representatives
10 and further provides that any representative to the Papago Council may
11 resign his office by giving written notice to the Chairman, and
12 such resignation shall take effect upon acceptance by the Papago
13 Council;
14 WHEREAS, The representative from Pisinemo has tendered his resignation for
15 personal reasons and has notified the Chairman in accordance with
16 the Uniform Election ordinance;
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
18 accept the resignation of Lamando Francisco, representative of the
19 Pisinemo District, such resignation to be effective June 8, 1984.
20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
21 day of June, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 1248.5 for; -0- against; 191.0 not voting; and -0- absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of
24 Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
26 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
27 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
28 the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
29 by the Papago Council.
