

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Appointment of members by Acclamation of the Health Board


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has long recognized the importance of improving
2 the delivery of health care services to its people; and
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has developed periodically health goals and objectives
4 in order to offer viable choices in health care and to enhance the
5 educational information available concerning health programs or
6 services; and
7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did appoint a health task force to review and
8 evaluate the health programs which recommended the reorganization of
9 all health programs and the appointment of a health board; and
10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
11 create and recognize the Health Board as a Board and does hereby
12 appoint by Acclamation the following individuals Madeline Sakistewa,
13 Lucy Mike, Irene Wallace, Sharmane Garcia, Andrew Lorentine, RoseMary
14 Lopez and Fred Stevens.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
16 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent,
18 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of
19 Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
20 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
21 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
22 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
23 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
24 ment by the Papago Council.
