

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Tuberculosis Control Program


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has operated a tuberculosis control program to help  
2 prevent the disease by altering susceptibility or reducing exposure  
3 for susceptible individuals; and  
4 WHEREAS, Funding for the operation of the Papago Tuberculosis Control program  
5 has been provided in part through supplemental funding sources; and  
6 WHEREAS, The Papago Tuberculosis Control program office desires to continue  
7 the services it provides to TB susceptible clients during the next  
8 fiscal year; and  
9 WHEREAS, Funding is available from the Department of Health Services, State  
10 of Arizona for eligible applicants;  
11 WHEREAS, The Papago Tuberculosis Control program has recieved funding from  
12 the Department of Health Services for its program and there appears  
13 to be no reason for the Department to deny funding for FY'85;  
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve  
15 the proposal for funding of the Papago Tuberculosis Control program  
16 from the Department of Health Services, State of Arizona; and  
17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice  
18 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized and  
19 directed to negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments.  
20 and documents necessary to secure funding for the operation of the  
21 Papago Tuberculosis Control Program.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st  
23 day of June, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
24 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent,  
25 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and  
26 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
27 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved  
28 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
29 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
30 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
31 its enactment by the Papago Council.
