

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Wise Ones Elderly Program

Title III

Res. No. 127-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has operated successfully a program for elderly
2 members and residents of the Papago Reservation called the Wise Ones
Elderly Program; and

3 WHEREAS, Funding for the Wise Ones Elderly Program has been provided in part
4 by Title III to the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended through
5 the administration by the InterTribal Council of Arizona; and

6 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly Program will require continued financial
7 assistance to continue providing minimum services to eligible
clients; and

8 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly Program has prepared a proposal for FY'85
9 for Title III funding to provide transportation, homecare and other
support services to eligible elderly clients; and


10 WHEREAS, The continued operation of the elderly program will be beneficial to
11 elderly clients;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby approves
13 the proposal for Title III funding for the Wise Ones Elderly Program
14 to continue to provide such services as it has proposed in light of
the requirements and regulations;


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
16 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized and
17 directed to negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments
and other necessary documents to secure funding for the continued
operation of the Wise Ones Elderly Program.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st
19 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
21 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
22 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
23 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
ment by the Papago Council.
