8	WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly Program has prepared a proposal for FY'85							
	for Title III funding to provide transportation, homecare and other							
9	support services to eligible elderly clients; and							
10	WHEREAS, The continued operation of the elderly program will be beneficial to							
11	elderly clients;							
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby approves							
	the proposal for Title III funding for the Wise Ones Elderly Program							
13	to continue to provide such services as it has proposed in light of							
14	the requirements and regulations;
