


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Wise Ones Elderly Program
Title VI



1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has successfully operated a program of services for
2 older tribal members through the office of the Wise Ones Elderly
3 Program; and
4 WHEREAS, Funding for the operation of the Wise Ones Elderly Program has been
5 possible in part by Article VI of the Older American's Act of 1965
6 as amended; and
7 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding of
8 its program for elderly by submitting a proposal to the Office of
9 Human Development Services, Administration on Aging; and
10 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly proposal will benefit elder members of the
11 Tribe by providing for their nutritional and other social and
12 support services;
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
14 approve the proposal to the Office of Human Development for continued
15 funding of the Wise Ones Elderly Program to provide services to
16 qualified residents of the Papago Reservation.
17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,
18 Francisco Jose, Vice Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are
19 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all contracts,
20 amendments and documents necessary to secure funding for the con-
21 tinued operation of the Wise Ones Elderly Program.
22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st
23 day of June, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
24 vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent
25 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d)
26 and (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
27 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
28 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
29 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not
30 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the
31 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
