20	approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not						
21	subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
