1	WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has successfully operated an Alcoholism Program for
2	its people; and
3	WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes that Alcoholism is one of the most
4	pressing and chronic health problems confronting the Papago people; and
5	WHEREAS, The Papago Alcoholism program intends to continue providing services
6	to eligible clients by structuring its program into three areas: youth services, adult services and operation of a Rehabilitation
7	Center; and
8	WHEREAS, The Federal Regulations, to wit: 25 CFR 371.20 require that all
9	proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 regulations be submitted
10	for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract termination; and WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe proposes to continue the Papago Alcoholism program
11	during FY'85 by contracting for P. L. 93-638 funds;
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does request the
13	Public Health Service, Indian Health Service to contract with the Papago Tribe pursuant to P. L. 93-638 and its regulations and
14	procedures for the operation of a Papago Alcoholism Prevention,
15	Education and Rehabilitation Program; and
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will be from
17	October 01, 1984 through September 30, 1985 unless extended by
	mutual agreement of both contracting parties; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event this contract is not in effect on
18	October 01, 1984, the existing FY'84 contract will be continued until
19	such time as the FY'85 contract is in effect;
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Tribe will not
21	fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are
22	still being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by
23	Indian Health Services; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
24	Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized and
25	directed to negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments
	and documents necessary for the implementation of the contract.

28	of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
	(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizon as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
2930	the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of th Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
31	ment by the Papago Council.
