


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Mental Health Program



1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has operated a program entitled the Papago
2 Psychological Service Program designed to provide professional mental
3 health services to eligible clients; and
4 WHEREAS, Funding for the program has been provided in large by the Indian Health
5 Service which the Papago Tribe has contracted to administer through
6 a P. L. 93-638 contract; and
7 WHEREAS, The Papago Psychological Program has been successful and beneficial
8 for the Papago Tribe and its people and there is no reason why the
9 program should not continue; and
10 WHEREAS, The Federal Regulations, to wit: 25 CFR 371.20 require that all
11 proposals for recontracting pursuant to P. L. 93-638 be submitted to
12 approval at least 120 days prior to the contract termination; and
13 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe does desire to recontract for the continued operation
14 of the Papago Psychological Service Program during FY'85;
15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does request the
16 Public Health Service, Indian Health service to contract with the
17 Papago Tribe pursuant to P. L. 93-638 and its regulations and proce-
18 dures for the operation of the Papago Psychological Service Program;
19 and
20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will be from
21 October 01, 1984 through September 30, 1985 unless extended by mutual
22 agreement of both contracting parties;
23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event this contract is not in effect on
24 October 01, 1984 the existing FY'84 contract will be continued until
25 such time as the FY'85 contract is in effect; and
26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Tribe will not
27 fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are
28 still being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by the
29 Indian Health Service; and
30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
31 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized and
32 directed to negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments
and documents necessary to the implementation of the contract.
The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st
day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 3 absent,
pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d)
of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
ment by the Papago Council.
