1	WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has operated a program entitled the Papago
2	Psychological Service Program designed to provide professional mental
	health services to eligible clients; and
3	WHEREAS, Funding for the program has been provided in large by the Indian Health
4	Service which the Papago Tribe has contracted to administer through
5	a P. L. 93-638 contract; and
6	WHEREAS, The Papago Psychological Program has been successful and beneficial
7	for the Papago Tribe and its people and there is no reason why the
8	program should not continue; and WHEREAS, The Federal Regulations, to wit: 25 CFR 371.20 require that all
	proposals for recontracting pursuant to P. L. 93-638 be submitted to
9	approval at least 120 days prior to the contract termination; and
10	WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe does desire to recontract for the continued operation
11	of the Papago Psychological Service Program during FY'85;
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does request the
13	Public Health Service, Indian Health service to contract with the
	Papago Tribe pursuant to P. L. 93-638 and its regulations and procedures for the operation of the Papago Psychological Service Program;

15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will be from
16	October 01, 1984 through September 30, 1985 unless extended by mutual
17	agreement of both contracting parties;
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event this contractis not in effect on
19	October 01, 1984 the existing FY'84 contract will be continued until
	such time as the FY'85 contract is in effect; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Tribe will not
20	fund or operate the porgram in the interim while negotiations are
21	still being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by the
22	Indian Health Service; and
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
24	Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized and
25	directed to negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments
	and documents necessary to the implementation of the contract. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st
26	day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
27	of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d)
28	of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
29	the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
30	Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
31	ment by the Papago Council.
