

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Adoption into Tribal Membership


1 WHEREAS, LEON, Benino, LEON, Frances, LEON, Maria Rufina, JUAN, Agnes B.
2 (Salcido), CASTANEDA, Alexandrina M., CASTANEDA, Andres J., CASTANEDA,
3 Leticia D., CASTANEDA, Ricardo, LOPEZ, Lola, VALDEZ, Juanita (Lopez)
4 have made application for adoption into Tribal membership pursuant
5 to Section 2 of Article II of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe; and
6 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed their respective applications,
7 has made a final determination that they are 1-½ degree or more of
8 Papago Indian blood, and have made a recommendations to the Papago
9 Council that their applications be approved, all in accordance with
10 the provisions with the Papago Enrollment Ordinance; and
11 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the
12 Enrollment Committee and the evidence submitted in support
13 of the individual applications.
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications
15 for adoptions filed by LEON, Benino, LEON, Frances, LEON, Maria Rufina,
16 JUAN, Agnes B. (Salcido), CASTANEDA, Alexandrina M., CASTANEDA, Andres
17 J., CASTANEDA, Leticia D., CASTANEDA, Ricardo, LOPEZ, Lola, VALDEZ,
18 Juanita (Lopez) are hereby approved and they are hereby adopted into
19 membership of the Papago Tribe.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 27th
21 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
22 vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and
24 Article V, Section 2 (f) of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe
25 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
26 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
27 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
28 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
29 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
