Ruiz, Treasurer, are hereby authorized to apply for, and negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments and other documents necessary to secure funding for the continued operation of the Papago Food Distribution program.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -1- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
