

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Papago Farming Authority
Jobs Bill

Res. No. 136-84

1 WHEREAS, The Emergency Jobs Bill, P.L. 98-8 has appropriated funds for
2 irrigation improvement programs; and
3 WHEREAS, The Vaiva Vo and Papago Farms are eligible projects to receive funding
4 under the jobs bill; and
5 WHEREAS, The Papago Farming Authority has prepared scopes of work for both
6 the Papago Farms and Vaiva Vo farms to satisfy the requirements of
7 the jobs bill to provide labor intensive work and to improve and
8 design the irrigation systems at both farms; and
9 WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes the urgency and spirit in which the
10 jobs bill was passed and would like to begin the projects as soon
11 as possible; and
12 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe desires to contract for the administration of the
13 jobs bill funds appropriated for irrigation improvement projects
14 in order to expedite the projects;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize and
16 request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the Papago
17 Tribe pursuant to P.L. 93-638 and its regulations and procedures
18 for the administration of Jobs Bill funds earmarked for irrigation
19 improvement projects; and


20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby requests the
21 Bureau of Indian Affairs to waive all time period requirements in
22 view of the timeframes for expending the funds, and negotiate and
23 award a Contract with the Papago Tribe;

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Contract will begin upon completion of
25 negotiations and awarding of a Contract and will terminate upon
26 completion of the projects outlined in the scope of work;

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,
28 Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, is hereby authorized
29 to apply for, and negotiate and execute any and all contracts,
30 amendments and other documents necessary for the implementation
31 of this Contract.


32 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1440.0 for; -0- against; 168.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article
V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
