

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Managers Dam Communal Farms

Res. No. 138-84

1 WHEREAS, The Manager's Dam Community has operated the Manager's Dam Communal
2 Farms as a cooperative, communal farm; and
3 WHEREAS, The Community has determined that a more efficient and improved
4 irrigation system would develop the farms into a more productive
5 and profitable effort; and
6 WHEREAS, The Community is aware of P.L. 98-8, Emergency Jobs Bill, which
7 authorized funds for the improvement and repair of existing
8 irrigation systems toward the objective of preserving and improv-
9 ing the natural resources of Indian tribes; and
10 WHEREAS, The Manager's Dam Community is desirous of securing any residual or
11 unobligated jobs bill funds designated for improvement and
12 repair of irrigation systems; and
13 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe, would, on the Community's behalf, contract for
14 such funds pursuant to the authorities and procedures of P.L. 93-638;


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
16 authorize and direct the Bureau of Indian Affairs to identify any
17 residual or unobligated jobs bill funds designated for repair or
18 improvement of irrigation systems and enter into a Contract with
19 the Papago Tribe pursuant to P.L. 93-638 and its regulations
20 to improve the existing irrigation system and replace the existing
21 water outlet valve at Manager's Dam Communal Farms; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,
23 or Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, are
24 hereby authorized and directed to apply for, negotiate and execute
25 such contracts, amendments and other documents necessary to imple-
26 ment the intent of this Resolution; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the duration of this
28 Contract will begin upon awarding of the negotiated Contract and
29 will terminate upon completion of the work proposed.

30 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
31 day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
32 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article
V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
