

RESOLUTION OF THE PAAPGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Gu Vo Youth Budget



1 WHEREAS, The Gu Vo District Council did by Resolution No. 20-84 approve the  
2 development of a summer youth program to employ District Youth; and  
3 WHEREAS, The Gu Vo District Council has approved an amendment to its FY 84  
4 Budget increasing the budget to \$20,490.00; and  
5 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed expenditure of Gu Vo  
6 District funds for the benefit of youth and approves of the same;  
7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby approves  
8 of an amendment to the Gu Vo District FY 84 budget of \$20,490.00  
9 to be expended in accordance with the attached budget and authorized  
10 the same

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Treasurer is authorized to withdraw  
12 transfer, deposit and/or oversee all financial transactions as may be  
13 necessary to implement the objective of the Summer Youth program in  
14 accordance with District wishes.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
16 day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
17 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to  
18 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article  
19 V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
20 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
21 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
22 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
23 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
24 the Papago Council.
