

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Infant Stimulation Grant

Res. No. 142-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has operated an Early Childhood education program  
2 for the benefit of children under the age of 5 years; and

3 WHEREAS, One of the programs offered by the early childhood education pro-  
4 gram is the stimulation of infants who have been determined to be  
5 slow in one or more areas of development; and

6 WHEREAS, Funds for education of handicapped children is authorized by P.L.  
7 94-142 and the Papago Tribe has been a recipient of funds to operate  
8 its Infant Stimulation program; and


9 WHEREAS, More and more children are being identified handicapped in varying  
10 degrees and continuation of the infant stimulation program will  
11 benefit these children;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does support and  
13 approve of the application for continued funding of the Infant  
14 Stimulation program to provide services to eligible children; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman  
16 Francisco Jose, Jr, Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, are  
17 hereby authorized and directed to apply for, and execute any and  
18 all contracts, amendments and documents necessary to secure funding  
19 for the continued operation of the Infant Stimulation program.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
21 day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
22 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
23 authority vested in the Papago Council by Seciton 2 (a) and (h) of Article V  
24 of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
25 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
26 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
27 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
28 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
29 the Papago Council.
