

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Authorized Budget Amendment for Sells
Service Station Sells District

Res. No. 145-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did authorize the Sells District to negotiate and
2 assume responsibility over operations involving the Indian Oasis
3 Service Station; and

4 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council has determined that it will operate the
5 Service Station for the remainder of FY-84 at a cost of \$48,200.00


6 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council did approve a budget amendment to its
7 FY 84 budget, said amendment reflecting estimated costs to operate
8 the Service Station for three months;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it has reviewed the
10 proposed budget amendment by the Sells District Council to its FY 84
11 budget and approves of the same;


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the original budget amount of \$294,468 is increased
13 to \$343,668, reflecting the addition of \$48,200.00 the amount Sells
14 District estimates it will cost to operate the service station for
15 the remainder of FY-84

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
17 day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -1- absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V
20 of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
21 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
22 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
23 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
24 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
25 the Papago Council.
