

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Addition of Section 4 to Article II Membership of the proposed
Constitution of murder or voluntary manslaughter as the major
crimes for disenrollment

Res. No. 146-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 111-84 move to have persons
2 convicted of felonious crimes, namely, murder and voluntary manslaugh-
3 ter disenrolled from membership with the Papago Tribe; and
4 WHEREAS, Each of the eleven Districts took this action under consideration and
5 reported back to the Papago Council its feelings on the action;
6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Resolution No. 111-84
7 stating that persons convicted of felonious crimes, namely, murder
8 and voluntary manslaughter would be disenrolled is hereby rescinded
9 in full and shall have no further effect.


8 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th
9 day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
10 694.5 for; 571. against; 174.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
11 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V and
12 Article IX of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
13 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December, 12, 1936, and approved by
14 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
15 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
16 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
17 its enactment by the Papago Council.
