

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Official Response from Housing and Urban Development

Res. No. 158-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Utility Authority (PTUA) has advised the Papago
2 Council of Housing Urban Development (HUD) practices of insisting
3 on outside contracts doing on site utility work on HUD projects; and
4 WHEREAS, PTUA has developed the required knowledge and experience to plan,
5 design, engineer and construct water and wastewater facilities to
6 meet HUD requirements; and
7 WHEREAS, PTUA's involvement in HUD projects would provide meaningful employment
8 for Papago members; and
9 WHEREAS, The Papago Housing Authority has been supportive of PTUA's efforts
10 to perform the work for HUD; and
11 WHEREAS, HUD has failed to provide an official response to inquiries by PTUA
12 about future projects;
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby supports
14 the Papago Tribal Utility Authority (PTUA) efforts and requests an
15 official response from appropriate officials of the Department of
16 Housing and Urban Development as to any reasons it has for not allow-
17 ing PTUA to construct certain utility work.


14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
15 day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the
17 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (f) of Article V
18 of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
20 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
21 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
22 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
23 the Papago Council.
