

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Reappointment of TERO Commission - Delma Garcia



1 WHEREAS, The Papago Employment Rights Ordinance, No. 1-78 provides for the
2 creation of a Papago Employment Rights Commission composed of three
3 memembers; and
4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did appoint Delma Garcia as a member of the Tribal
5 Employment Rights Commission to a two year term which has expired as
6 of July 13, 1984, and it is necessary to reappoint her or appoint a
7 successor; and
8 WHEREAS, The Tribal Employment Rights office director and two other Commission-
9 ers have expressed their strong recommendations that Delma Garcia be
10 reappointed as a Commissioner; and
11 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is satisfied that Delma Garcia has served the
12 Commission with integrity and dedication; and


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does reappoint
14 Delma Garcia to the Tribal Employment Rights Commission for a term of
15 three years, starting July 13, 1984 and ending July 13, 1987.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
17 day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V
20 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
21 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Sec-
22 retary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
23 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
24 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
25 enactment by the Papago Council.
