	WHEREAS, The Papago Council did appoint Delma Garcia as a member of the Tribal						
4	Employment Rights Commission to a two year term which has expired as						
5	of July 13, 1984, and it is necessary to reappoint her or appoint a successor; and						
6	WHEREAS, The Tribal Employment Rights office director and two other Commission						
7	ers have expressed their strong recommendations that Delma Garcia be						
8	reappointed as a Commissioner; and						
9	WHEREAS, The Papago Council is satisfied that Delma Garcia has served the						
	Commission with integrity and dedication; and						
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does reappoint						
11	Delma Garcia to the Tribal Employment Rights Commission for a term of						
12	three years, starting July 13, 1984 and ending July 13, 1987.						
13	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th day of July, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the						
14	authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V						
15	of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Sec-						
16	retary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review						
	by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
