

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Papago Council to provide financial assistance to  
the O'odham Construction and Materials Company

Res. No. 163-84

1 WHEREAS, The O'odham Construction and Materials Company was established by  
2 the Papago Council by Resolution No. 58-80; and  
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised of the financial and management  
4 status of O'odham Construction and Materials Company; and  
5 WHEREAS, It is the decision of the Papago Council to provide financial  
6 assistance for the continued operation of the O'odham Construction  
7 and Materials Company; and  
8 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Papago Council that \$840,000 be made  
9 available from the Papago Tribe's Investment Account established  
10 with interest received from the Land Judgment Settlement Act, to  
11 O'odham Construction and Materials Company to complete all projects;  
12 and  
13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all payments made by O'odham Construction and  
14 Materials Company be based on expenditures and that all expenditures  
15 be monitored by the Executive Office and the Tribal Accounting  
16 Department.  
17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st  
18 day of August, 1984 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
19 1440.00 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
20 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and Section 3 (a) of  
21 Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
22 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
23 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of  
25 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is  
26 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
