11	Materials Company be based on expenditures and that all expenditures						
12	be monitored by the Executive Office and the Tribal Accounting						
	Department.

16	Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as						
17	amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by						
18	the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of						
19	the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is						
20	subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
