## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Appointment of a Committee to investigate/review the status of the O'odham Construction and Materials Company

Res. No. 164-84

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised of the status of O'odham Construction and Materials Company; and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Papago Council to appoint a Committee of persons who will investigate/review the status of O'odham Construction and Materials Company and determine what course of action to take concerning the operations of O'odham Construction and Materials Company; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does here by authorize the Executive Office to appoint a Committee of persons with authority to review the status and management issues confronting the operations and functions of O'odham Construction and Materials Company and to recommend a plan of operation consistent with Tribal goals; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a report be made to the Papago Council within 2 months.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st day of August, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
