- WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona is an elegible local government entitled to general revenue funds and the Tribe's entitlement totals \$203,536.00; and
- WHEREAS, The major objective of the Revenue Sharing Act is to disburse Federal funds with minimum restrictions on use, and to permit local governments to determine the programs and activities to be funded from general revenue sharing funds; and
- WHEREAS, A portion of Revenue Sharing funds has, in the past, been set aside to pay for costs associated with administration of the Revenue Sharing program; and
- WHEREAS, The Papago Council proposes to distribute the total entitlement to each of the eleven Districts in equal amounts without allocating any portion for administration costs; and
- WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes the special needs of the handicapped;

 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that General Revenue

 Sharing Funds for entitlement period, beginning October 1, 1984 and
 ending September 30, 1985 shall be equally distributed to each of
 the eleven Districts, such amount to be \$14,866.91, and that each of
 the Districts will assess the needs of its handicapped citizens and
 use funds in accordance therewith;

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of August, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 448.0 for; 825 against; 113.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
