

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Revenue Sharing--Equal Distribution to each of the Eleven Districts)  
(None for administration)

RES. NO. 165-84

1 WHEREAS, The Revenue Sharing Act, as amended by the Local Government Fiscal  
2 Assitance Act Amendments of 1983 (Pub. L. 98-185) authorizes the  
3 appropriation of General Revenue Sharing funds to elegeible State and  
4 Local governments; and

5 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona is an elegeible local government entitled  
6 to general revenue funds and the Tribe's entitlement totals  
7 \$203,536.00; and

8 WHEREAS, The major objective of the Revenue Sharing Act is to disburse Federal  
9 funds with minimum restrictions on use, and to permit local governments  
10 to determine the programs and activities to be funded from general  
11 revenue sharing funds; and

12 WHEREAS, A portion of Revenue Sharing funds has, in the past, been set aside  
13 to pay for costs associated with administration of the Revenue  
14 Sharing program; and

15 WHEREAS, The Papago Council proposes to distribute the total entitlement to  
16 each of the eleven Districts in equal amounts without allocating any  
17 portion for administration costs; and

18 WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes the special needs of the handicapped;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that General Revenue  
20 Sharing Funds for entitlement period, beginning October 1, 1984 and  
21 ending September 30, 1985 shall be equally distributed to each of  
22 the eleven Districts, such amount to be \$14,866.91, and that each of  
23 the Districts will assess the needs of its handicapped citizens and  
24 use funds in accordance therewith;

25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
26 day of August, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
27 of 448.0 for; 825 against; 113.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the  
28 authority in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the  
29 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified  
30 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of  
the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its  
approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review  
by the Secretary of the Interior.
