## Revenue Sharing-Equal Distribution to each of the eleven Districts (\$40,000.00 reserved for Administration)

1	WHEREAS, The Revenue Sharing Act, as amended by the Local Government Fiscal						
2	Assistance Act Amendments of 1983 (Pub. L. 98-185) authorizes the						
3	appropriation of General Revenue Sharing funds to legible State and local governments; and						
4	WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona is an eligible local government entitled						
5	to general revenue funds and the Tribe's entitlement totals \$203,536.00; and						
6	WHEREAS, The major objective of the Revenue Sharing Act is to disburse Fed-						
7	eral funds with minimum restrictions on use, and to permit local						
8	governments to determine the programs and activities to be funded from general revenue sharing funds; and						
9	WHEREAS, The Papago Council has satisfied the requirements set forth in the						
10	Federal Register for receipt of general revenue sharing funds; and						
11	WHEREAS, The Papago Council has found that each of the eleven Districts are						
	best suited and in a position to determine the needs of its citizens;						
12	and						
13	WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes the special needs of handicapped per-						
14	sons; and						
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that General Revenue Sharing funds for entitlement period October 1, 1984 to September 30,						
16	1985 shall be equally distributed to each of the eleven Districts of						
17	the Papago Tribe, such amount to be \$14,866.91; and that each of the						
18	Districts will assess the needs of its handicapped citizens and use						
	funds in accordance therewith; and						
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that \$40,000.00 is reserved for						
20	administration.						
21	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of August, 1984 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1325.5 for; -O- against; 61.0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the						
22	authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,						
23	ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the						
24	Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the
