


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Revenue Sharing-Equal Distribution to each of the eleven Districts
(\$40,000.00 reserved for Administration)


Res No 166-84

1 WHEREAS, The Revenue Sharing Act, as amended by the Local Government Fiscal
2 Assistance Act Amendments of 1983 (Pub. L. 98-185) authorizes the
3 appropriation of General Revenue Sharing funds to legible State and
4 local governments; and
5 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona is an eligible local government entitled
6 to general revenue funds and the Tribe's entitlement totals
7 \$203,536.00; and
8 WHEREAS, The major objective of the Revenue Sharing Act is to disburse Fed-
9 eral funds with minimum restrictions on use, and to permit local
10 governments to determine the programs and activities to be funded
11 from general revenue sharing funds; and
12 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has satisfied the requirements set forth in the
13 Federal Register for receipt of general revenue sharing funds; and
14 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has found that each of the eleven Districts are
15 best suited and in a position to determine the needs of its citizens;
16 and
17 WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes the special needs of handicapped per-
18 sons; and
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that General Revenue
20 Sharing funds for entitlement period October 1, 1984 to September 30,
21 1985 shall be equally distributed to each of the eleven Districts of
22 the Papago Tribe, such amount to be \$14,866.91; and that each of the
23 Districts will assess the needs of its handicapped citizens and use
24 funds in accordance therewith; and
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that \$40,000.00 is reserved for
26 administration.


27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day
28 of August, 1984 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
29 1325.5 for; -0- against; 61.0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the
30 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V
31 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
32 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the
date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

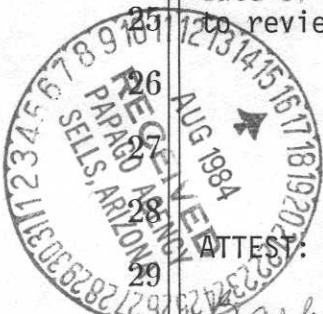
