

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Amending General Counsel Contract

Res No 168-84

1 WHEREAS, The law firm of Strickland & Altaffer was by General Counsel Contract
2 (Symbol H50C1420-Contract number 3752) employed as general counsel to
3 represent the Papago Tribe for a period of two years, effective Sep-
4 tember 25, 1983, through September 24, 1985; and


4 WHEREAS, At the time said contract was executed neither the Tribe nor its
5 general counsel could accurately anticipate the amount of time which
6 would be required to represent the Tribe and an annual limitation of
7 \$198,600.00 was placed upon fees and expenses to be incurred under the
8 contract; and

8 WHEREAS, The Tribe's general counsel have rendered services to the Tribe in
9 excess of the number of hours originally estimated and it is anticipa-
10 ted that substantially more services will be required in the future;


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the \$198,600.00
12 limitation on legal fees and expenses set in the General Counsel
13 Contract with the law firm of Strickland & Altaffer be increased to
14 \$250,000.00, and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council
15 are hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Amendment
16 to the General Counsel Contract for and on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th day
17 of August, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 1026.00 for; 254.5 against; 52.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
19 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (b) and Section 3 (a)
20 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as
21 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
22 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
23 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as
24 of the of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency
25 and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


