

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolution requesting support to the Phoenix
Service Unit Indian Health Board, Inc.

RES No 172-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe recognizes its right to address the health needs
2 of its members as identified below in the way it chooses; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe believes that said health services can best be pro-
4 vided to its members by working together with other tribes in tribal
5 organizations; and

6 WHEREAS, The Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Board, Inc., (PSUIHB) is a
7 legally established non-profit organization, whose governing body is
8 composed of tribal representatives and includes the maximum par-
9 ticipation of Indian people in all phases of its activity; and


10 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe wishes to establish the eligibility of the PSUIHB,
11 Inc., to contract with the Indian Health Service (IHS) on its behalf,
12 consistent with tribal resolution requirements; and

13 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that:


- 14 1. The Papago Tribe designates the PSUIHB, Inc., as its tribal
15 organization within the purposes set out below.
- 16 2. The Papago Tribe requests the Secretary of Health and Human
17 Services to enter into a contract with PSUIHB, Inc., on be-
18 half of the Papago Tribe, according to the terms and conditions
19 of this Resolution.
- 20 3. The Papago Tribe authorizes the PSUIHB, Inc., to apply for,
21 negotiate and enter into a contract with the Indian Health Service
22 (IHS), subject only to the specific terms, conditions and limita-
23 tions of this Resolution and applicable tribal laws, codes, regu-
24 lations and customs of the Papago Tribe.
- 25 4. The scope of said P.L. 93-638 contract shall include:
 - 26 a) Administrative Services for the contract.
 - 27 b) Community Health Representative Program at the
 - 28 Yavapai-prescott Indian Community.
 - 29 c) Patient Representative Program
 - 30 d) Tuberculosis Control Program
 - 31 e) Home Health Care Program
 - 32 f) Eyeglass Program
 - g) Orthodontic Program
 - h) National Health Service Corp. Dental Project Gila Crossing
 - i) Guiding Star Lodge
 - j) Substance Abuse
5. Final approval of the Papago Tribe to the terms of said contract
shall be through the consent to the Tribe's representative on the
PSUIHB, Inc., Board of Directors.
6. Copies of documents and correspondences relating to said contract
shall be sent to the Papago tribal office located at P.O. Box 837,
Sells, Arizona 85634.
7. The term of said contract with PSUIHB, Inc., and the Papago Tribe
shall be from October 1, 1985 to September 30, 1987.
8. Other than those specifically outlined above, there are no
limitations on the authority granted to PSUIHB, Inc., relating to
said contract.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th
2 day of August, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
3 of 1258.0 for; 75.0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
4 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) (m) of Article
5 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
6 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
7 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
8 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
9 review by the secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date
10 of its enactment by the Papago Council.
