


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Tribal Budget Amendment - FY 1984)

RES. NO. 17-84


1 WHEREAS, the Papato Council did by Resolution No. 138-83, approve and adopt  
2 a tribal budget in the amount of \$4,668,200.00 to be expended  
3 beginning October 1, 1983, through September 30, 1984, for the  
4 expenses of tribal business and government; and  
5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 190-83, approve of the  
6 continued deferment of \$60,000.00 in the monthly payment of advance  
7 royalties paid the Papago Tribe under the terms of the mining  
8 lease with Noranda Exploration, Inc., until September 30, 1984; and  
9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the approved tribal budget for  
10 fiscal year 1984 and finds that an amendment is required to reflect  
11 the reduction in revenue as a result of the deferment.  
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the fiscal year  
13 1984 tribal budget is amended as follows: the projected total  
14 expenditure of \$4,668,200.00 is reduced by \$540,000.00, making the  
15 total amount now available for expenditure \$4,128,200.00, specifically,  
16 that the reduction will be reflected under Account 84-1-1003-9080,  
17 Administration/Provisions, originally budgeted for \$590,500.00 to  
18 be reduced by \$540,000.00 now making the budgeted amount \$50,500.00.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th  
20 day of February, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
21 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0  
22 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a)  
23 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
24 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
25 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
26 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
27 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago  
28 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
