17	WHEREAS,	The Papago Indian Housing Authority (herein called "Local Authority")							
18		is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a							
19		preliminary loan to cover the costs of surveys and planning in con- nection with the development of low-income housing;							
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Council of the Papago Tribe as								
	follows:								
21		1. That there exists within the jurisdiction of this Governing Council							
22		a need for such low-income housing which is not being met by pri- vate enterprise.							
23		2. That the application of the local Authority to the Government for							
24		a preliminary loan in an amount not to exceed 3 percent of the							
25		Total Development Cost which can be supported by the amount of the ACC for surveys and planning in connection with low-income housing							
26		projects of not to exceed approximately 50 dwelling units is here- by approved.							
27		3. That there is no objection to the Local Authority's application to							
28		HUD for additional housing, (a) due to any inconsistency with a HUD-approved Housing Assistance Plan for the locality or localities							
29		under consideration; or (b) since a definite need for the housing							
30		exists even though a Housing Assistance Plan may not be in effect; and (c) since public facilities and services are or will be avail-							
		able and adequate to serve the proposed housing in the areas mentioned,
