

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Amending Transaction Privilege Taxes Ordinance
(Ordinance 03-81)
(Res. No. 190-84)

Res. No. 190-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on September 3, 1981, enact the Transaction
 2 Privilege Taxes Ordinance of the Papago Tribe, Ordinance No. 03-81
 3 effective October 1, 1981; and
 4 WHEREAS, Administration of the ordinance is vested in the Treasurer of the
 5 Papago Tribe; and
 6 WHEREAS, The Treasurer has advised the Papago Council that her office has
 7 experienced substantial difficulties in collecting privilege taxes
 8 due from prime contractors whose principal businesses are located
 9 off the Papago Reservation, and the Treasurer has recommended that
 10 the Papago Council amend Section 4 and 5 of Transaction Privilege
 11 Taxes Ordinance in accordance with the attached proposed Amendments
 12 to Transaction Privilege Taxes Ordinance in order to require prime
 13 contractors to furnish tax payment bonds as a condition of their
 14 privilege to engage in business on the Reservation; and
 15 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has received and reviewed testimony involving
 16 the Treasurer's recommendation and concurs therewith; and
 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
 18 adopt the attached Amendments to Transaction Privilege Taxes Or-
 19 dinance and that it does hereby amend Sections 4 and 5 of the or-
 20 dinance in accordance with the language therein set out; and
 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Ordinance No. 03-81 of the Papago Tribe, as
 22 amended by this Resolution, is hereby republished as the Transaction
 23 Privilege Taxes Ordinance of the Papago Council.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
 day of November, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
 the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e), (f), (h) and (m) and
 Section 3 (a), (b), (c), (e) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-
 laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December
 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
 of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

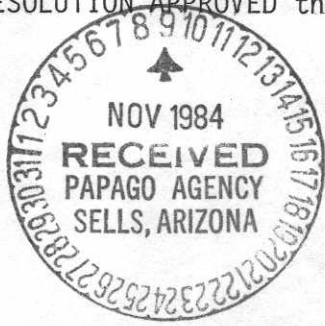
