

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement
Early Childhood Head Start/Home Start

Res No. 191-84

1 WHEREAS, The Child Care Food Program of the State of Arizona has funded break-
2 fast, lunch and snacks of the Papago Early Childhood Head Start/Home
3 Start by means of an Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement between
4 the Papago Tribe and the State of Arizona; and

5 WHEREAS, The Papago Early Childhood Head Start/Home Start has recommended re-
6 newal of said agreement, effective October 1, 1984; and


7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation and supports the
8 Early Childhood Head Start/Home Start continuance of the Child Care
9 Food Program; and

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
11 approve the renewal of the application implementing the Child Care
12 Food Program from October 1, 1984, through September 30, 1985; and


13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Papago Tribe is hereby auth-
14 orized to execute the Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement, or
15 any amendments thereto.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th, day
17 of September, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 1440.0 for; -0- agains; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(a) and (h) of Article V
20 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
21 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Sec-
22 retary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
23 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
24 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its en-
25 actment of the Papago Council.
