

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
License Agreement - Cable TV Service

Res No. 198-84

1 Resolution of the Papago Tribe hereby granting the non-exclusive rights, pri-  
2 vilege and license to lay and use lines, wires, coaxial cables and appurtenances  
3 for receiving, distributing and supplying radio, television, and other cable  
4 communication along, across and upon the public streets, ways, alleys, and places

5 WHEREAS, Papago Oasis Enterprises, Inc. is desirous of establishing, operating,  
6 and maintaining a cable television system serving the Sells Community;  
and

7 WHEREAS, The said corporation is willing to abide and be bound by that certain  
8 ordinance of the Papago Tribal Council, Cable Communication Ordinance  
9 No. 04-84; and


10 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council is desirous of granting a license to Papago  
11 Oasis Enterprises, Inc. to establish and maintain a Cable Communication  
System; and

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Papago Council hereby grants to Allen  
13 W. Garcia Jr., Papago Oasis Enterprises, Inc., a Non-Exclusive license  
14 and that all applicable provisions of the Cable Ordinance apply herein;  
and


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby grants Papago Oasis Enter-  
16 prises, Inc. a two (2) year waiver on Section 21, "License Fee", of  
the Cable Ordinance to allow stabilization of said business

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day  
18 of September, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
19 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to  
20 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article  
21 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Sec-  
retary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review  
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its en-  
actment by the Papago Council.
