13	W. Garcia Jr., Papago Oasis Enterprises, Inc., a Non-Exclusive license and that all applicable provisions of the Cable Ordinance apply herein;

15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby grants Papago Oasis Enter-
	prises, Inc. a two (2) year waiver on Section 21, "License Fee", of
16	the Cable Ordinance to allow stabilization of said business
