

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Change Dates of Rodeo & Fair
Appoint New Rodeo & Fair Committee


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Rodeo & Fair is an annual Tribal event; and
2 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has appointed a Rodeo & Fair Board to oversee the
planning of all activities associated with the Tribal Rodeo & Fair; and
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has received a status report on the proposed activ-
4 ities for November, 1984; and
5 WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes it would be in the Tribe's interest to
postpone the Tribal Rodeo & Fair indefinitely, and to allow Districts
6 to recommend individuals to the Rodeo & Fair Board; and
7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Annual Papago
8 Rodeo & Fair is hereby postponed indefinitely, and that each of the
Districts will recommend person (s) for membership to the Rodeo &
9 Fair Board.

10 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th. day
of September 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
11 1205.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article
12 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
13 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
14 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
