

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


San Xavier District Revenue Sharing Budget - FY 85

Res. No. 208-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe is the recipient of General Revenue Sharing funds
2 allocated to eligible local government units; and
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council authorizes and approves the expenditure of revenue
4 sharing funds in accordance with identified needs by each of the eleven
5 districts by requiring the Districts to submit budgets to the Papago
6 Council; and
7 WHEREAS, Each of the eleven Districts has, for previous entitlements budgeted
8 certain amounts of revenue sharing funds to cover anticipated costs
9 for prioritized projects and through no fault of their own, has not
10 expended such budgeted funds in the fiscal year proposed for such
11 projects; and
12 WHEREAS, The Tribal Accounting Department has provided each of the eleven
13 Districts computer print out sheets detailing budget balances from
14 previous entitlements; and
15 WHEREAS, It would be in the best interest of the Districts to amend their cur-
16 rent FY 85 Revenue Sharing budgets to include such balances previously
17 budgeted for specific projects; and
18 WHEREAS, This modification to the FY 85 Revenue Sharing Budgets would not change
19 District proposed plans and previously identified projects can continue
20 to be undertaken; and
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it has reviewed the
22 proposed amendment/modification to the San Xavier District's FY 85
23 Revenue Sharing Budget incorporating \$21,144.05 from previous Revenue
24 Sharing entitlements, and hereby approves the expenditure of such funds
25 in accordance with the attached budget.


26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th.
27 day of October, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
28 of 1318.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant
29 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of
30 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
31 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
32 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
