

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Amending Sells District Budget FY 85  
(Res. No. 209-84)

Res. No. 209-84

1 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council did on July 11, 1984 amend its FY 84  
2 budget to include a budget to operate the Sells Standard Service  
Station for a period of three months; and

3 WHEREAS, The Sells District advertised to hire a manager for the service  
4 station and received no qualified applicants; and

5 WHEREAS, The hiring of a manager would have enabled the District to begin  
6 operating the service station and begin expending the three month  
budget; and

7 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council is desirous of modifying the amended  
8 budget to again include the costs for operation and maintenance  
of the service station; and


9 WHEREAS, The Sells District has sufficient funds in its IIM account to  
10 cover the anticipated costs; and

11 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council is requesting the Papago Council  
to approve the modification; and


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
13 approve the Sells District Budget amendment to its FY 85  
14 approved budget to include a budget for costs and expenditures  
15 anticipated in the operation and maintenance of the Sells Service  
Station and hereby authorizes expenditures in accordance therewith.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
17 day of November, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
18 vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and  
20 Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago  
Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12,  
1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent  
of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
