
BIA to Seek Funds for Secretarial Election


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed and approved a final draft of the
2 Papago Constitution which will revise and amend the 1937 Constitution
3 and
4 WHEREAS, The final step required before the proposed draft Constitution becomes
5 law is to place the proposed draft before eligible votes of the
6 Papago Tribe; and
7 WHEREAS, 25 CFR 81 et Seq. provides the procedures for calling and holding the
8 election on the proposed Constitution; and
9 WHEREAS, The cost for the Secretarial election is a cost that can be legitimat-
10 ely paid by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
11 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has prepared an estimate of costs for conducting the
12 election and prepared a budget for submission to the Bureau of Indian
13 Affairs; and
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby re-
15 quest and authorize the Bureau of Indian Affairs to seek and fund the
16 cost for calling and holding a Secretarial Election for the purpose of
17 voting on the adoption of the proposed Constitution in the amount of
18 \$7,734.00 as proposed by the attached budget.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
16 day of November, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant
18 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3
19 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
20 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
21 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
22 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the
23 date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
24 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


