

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Appointment of Brooks Taylor to Farm Board)



1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 72-79, establish the
2 Papago Farming Authority and adopt a Plan of Operation granting
3 management power to a Management Board of eight (8) persons, five
4 (5) of whom must be members of the Papago Tribe and three (3) of
5 whom must be persons having not less than ten (10) years' experience
6 in farming or business management of substantial character; and
7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on November 5, 1980, by Resolution No. 121-80,
8 appoint eight persons to the Management Board upon alternating
9 terms; and
10 WHEREAS, the term of office of Brooks Taylor has expired and it is necessary
11 to appoint or reappoint a person having not less than ten (10) years'
12 experience in farming or business management of substantial character
13 to such office; and
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, in accordance
15 with the provisions of Section 8 of the Plan of Operation of the
16 Papago Farming Authority, the following person meeting the required
17 qualifications is hereby appointed as a director of the Management
18 Board for a term of three (3) years and until his successors has
19 been appointed and qualified:



18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th
19 of February, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
20 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant
21 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of
22 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
23 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
24 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section
25 16 of the Act of June 18, 1938 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject
26 to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date
27 of its enactment by the Papago Council.
