

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

San Lucy District Budget - FY 85

Res. No. 218-84

1 WHEREAS, The San Lucy District Council has developed and adopted an interim
 2 budget for FY 1985 designed to deliver services to its members; and
 3 WHEREAS, The interim budget proposes expenditures for 6 weeks, subject to
 4 amendments or modifications as may be necessary; and
 5 WHEREAS, The General Council recognizes the importance of the Districts needs
 6 and the services designed to address them; and
 7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve and
 8 authorize expenditures by the San Lucy District Council in accordance
 9 with the interim budget proposed and any and all amendments, modi-
 10 fications or changes shall be subject to Council review and approval.

11 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th.
 12 day of October, 1984 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
 13 876.5 for; 138.0 against; 425.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
 14 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and Section 3 (a)
 15 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
 16 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
