

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Gu Vo District Budget FY 85  
(1 Mo extension-use of 84 monies)

Res. No. 219-84

1 WHEREAS, The Gu Vo District Council did adopt a fiscal year 84 budget to cover  
2 the costs and expenses of providing certain services to its District  
3 members; and


4 WHEREAS, The Gu Vo District Council has not expended all the funds budgeted for  
5 use during the fiscal year; and

6 WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Gu Vo District Council to extend its FY 84  
7 budget year one month to expend the savings it has earned; and


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council has reviewed the Gu Vo  
9 District Council's budget extension and finds the same to be appropri-  
10 ate and, hereby approves the extension of the FY 84 budget one month  
11 expending FY 84 savings during the one month extension, and, hereby  
12 authorizes the Gu Vo District Council to expend the funds in accord-  
13 ance with the budget prepared for such use.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th.  
15 day of October, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
16 of 1237.0 for; -0- against; 203.0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant  
17 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and Section 3  
18 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe  
19 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
20 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
21 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
22 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago  
23 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
