

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Re-enactment of Tribal Resolutions
(190,197,209,211 and 212)

Res. No. 224-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on October 10 and 11, 1984 approve and enact
 2 Resolution Nos. 190, 197, 209, 211 and 212 ; and
 3 WHEREAS, The Papago Constitution provides that resolutions subject to approval
 4 by the Superintendent and review by the Secretary of the Interior
 5 will be presented to the Agency within ten days after enactment by
 6 the Papago Council;
 7 WHEREAS, The Resolution were submitted to the Agency on the thirteenth day,
 8 three days late prompting the Agency Superintendant to return the
 9 resolutions for re-enactment;

10 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby re-
 11 authorize and re-enact the following Resolutions:
 12 Amending Transaction Privilege Taxes Ordinance Res. 190-84
 13 Charter of Papago Oasis Enterprises, Inc. Res. 197-84
 14 Amending Sells District Budget FY 85 Res. 209-84
 15 Baboquivari District Budget FY 85 Res. 211-84
 16 BIA to Seek Funds for Secretarial Election Res. 212-84

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
 18 day of November, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
 19 vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent,
 20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a)
 21 (f) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws
 22 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on
 23 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January
 24 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
 25 Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
 26 Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary
 27 of the Interior.
