

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Re-enactment of Tribal Res. No. 153-84  
(Sif Oidak District Budget FY 85)

Res. No. 225-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on July 13, 1984 approve and enact Resolution  
2 No. 153-84; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Constitution provides that resolutions subject to approval  
4 by the Superintendent and review by the Secretary of the Interior must  
5 be presented to the Superintendent within ten days after enactment by  
6 the Papago Council; and

7 WHEREAS, The Resolution was submitted to the Superintendent on October 9, 1984,  
8 three months late, prompting the Superintendent to return the reso-  
9 lution for re-enactment; and

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
11 reauthorize and re-enact Resolution No. 153-84 - Sif Oidak District  
12 Budget FY 85.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th.  
14 day of November, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
15 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant  
16 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and Section 3  
17 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe  
18 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago  
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.




