

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Appointment of Papago Rodeo & Fair Board

Res. No. 227-84

- 1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has hosted a tribal rodeo & fair annually for the
2 past twenty years; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council identified individuals familiar with rodeo & fair
4 activities and events and appointed such individuals to form the Rodeo
5 & Fair Board; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on September 7, 1984 determine that the
7 existing Rodeo & Fair Board had not prepared adequately for the annual
8 event this year, and consequently, major unresolved problems would in
9 all possibility hinder a successful rodeo & fair; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 203-84 suspend the membership
11 of the current board members and directed each of the eleven District
12 representatives to seek board membership recommendations; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Districts have had opportunity to consider individuals for
14 membership on the Rodeo & Fair Board; and

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
16 appoint the following persons to the Rodeo & Fair Board for thirteen
17 (13) months.





25 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V
26 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
28 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
30 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
31 the Papago Council.
