

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Appointment of Gleason Norris to Farm Board)


RES. NO. 22-84

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 72-79, establish the  
2 Papago Farming Authority and adopt a Plan of Operation granting  
3 management power to a Management Board of eight persons, five of  
4 whom must be members of the Papago Tribe and three of whom must  
5 be persons having not less than ten years' experience in farming  
6 or business management of substantial character; and  
7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on November 5, 1980, by Resolution No. 121-80,  
8 appoint eight persons to the Management Board upon alternating terms;  
9 and  
10 WHEREAS, the term of office Gleason Norris has expired and it is necessary  
11 to appoint or reappoint a person of the Tribe to such office.  
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, in accordance  
13 with the provision of of Section 8 of the Plan of Operation of the  
14 Papago Farming Authority, the following person meeting the required  
15 qualifications is hereby appointed as a director of the Management  
16 Board for a term of three years and until his successors has been  
17 appointed and qualified:


Gleason Norris - Three Years

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th  
16 of February, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
17 of 1282.0 for; 0 against; 158.0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant  
18 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of  
19 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
20 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved  
21 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section  
22 16 of the Act of June 18, 1938 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject  
23 to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date  
24 of its enactment by the Papago Council.
