

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


San Lucy District
Other Revenues

Res. No. 234-84


1 WHEREAS, The San Lucy District through its own efforts generates rental income
2 and lease income; and
3 WHEREAS, The San Lucy District Council has determined the amount of income
4 generated through leasing, sufficient to cover costs and expenditures
5 for six months, October 1984 to March 1985; and
6 WHEREAS, The use of this income will supplement the District's own budget and
7 enable the District Revenue Sharing and IIM funds to be freed for other
8 purposes; and
9 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the Proposed use of other income
10 generated from leasing and rentals and finds the amount to be sufficient
11 to cover anticipated costs;
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the income generated
13 from rentals and leases entered into by the San Lucy District is
14 approved for use in accordance with the attached budget and hereby
15 authorizes expenditures in accordance therewith.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day
17 of November, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 882.5 for; 138 against; 419.5 not voting; and -1- absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V
20 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
21 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
22 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
23 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
24 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
25 the Papago Council.
