

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Chukut Kuk District Revenue Sharing Budget Fy - 1985

Res. No. 242-84


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has allocated \$30,220.54 of federal revenue  
2 sharing funds to the Chukut Kuk District; and  
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has heard evidence concerning the use of such  
4 funds pursuant to the requests presented at the public hearing,  
5 including the attached resolution of the District Council of Chukut  
6 Kuk District; and  
7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the attached budget and approves  
8 of same.  
9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the \$30,220.54 of  
10 federal revenue sharing funds allocated to the Chukut Kuk District  
11 be distributed in accordance with the requests presented at the  
12 public hearing and that it does hereby approve the attached 1985  
13 revenue sharing budget of the Chukut Kuk District and authorizes  
14 expenditure in accordance therewith.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
16 day of December, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
17 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to  
18 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article  
19 V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
20 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
21 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
22 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
23 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
24 the Papago Council.
